Gervais Public Works manages maintenance of city water, waste water and street system functions and quality as well as Gervais City property and buildings. The waste water (sewer) system is made up of approximately 3 miles of sewer lines and 2 pump stations. The sewer treatment plant consists of 3 treatment lagoons and 50 acres of



poplar trees. Irrigation of these trees comes from the 3rd lagoon. On average, the waste water flow is between 4.6 and 7.1 million gallons per month.
