



Summary of Infiltration/Inflow Related Activities for 2016

Dear Mr. Cole:

As required by the City's NPDES permit, this letter is provided as a summary of activities performed by the City related to the control of infiltration and inflow (I/I) into the sanitary sewer collection system.

The following activities were performed in 2016.

- 1. 1,850 lineal feet of the sanitary sewer was video inspected for general condition as well as infiltration sources. The infiltration observed from the video was not sufficient to warrant pipe repair work.
- 2. A new storm drain line was installed in Grove Ave. between 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Streets to address poor surface drainage in that area.
- 3. The Public Works Department continued to monitor the collection system for obvious inflow sources such as illicit connections.

The following I/I reduction related activities are planned to be performed in 2017:

- 1. Additional pipeline videoing and manhole inspection is planned for the next several months with the goal of identifying work for this summer that will provide a reasonable cost to benefit ratio.
- 2. The City Public Works Department will continue to monitor the collection system for obvious inflow.
